

Dear Sir/Madam,

We wish to comment on the inquiry into Commonwealth anti-discrimination law.

- We ask that no changes be made to increase the application of anti-discrimination law. All current anti-discrimination laws actually REMOVE freedom of choice by telling us that we CAN'T have our own opinions and values, and we have to normalise everyone. They don't breed acceptance, rather they tell us that we have to LOSE our values and pretend everything is acceptable. Anti-discrimination laws, whilst coming from good intention, actually smell of communism in how they are implemented and lived out.
- We strongly oppose anti-discrimination laws that are based on sexuality and gender identity. Homosexuality and confused gender identity are NOT innate characteristics, and homosexual relationships are NOT NATURAL. These are the products of a society that has forgotten how to train its people with moral dignity. Such anti-discrimination laws only FORCE everyone to accept homosexuality as somehow 'normal', and they will DENY freedom of choice and freedom of religion to the masses.
- Anti-discrimination laws have been shown time and again to NOT remove discrimination, but instead they only re-direct the discrimination against anyone who does not hold the popular opinion. Whilst coming from a good intention, anti-discrimination laws are actually self-defeating in practise.

The solution you're looking for:

Your goal is build a society whose people accept each other, despite their differences. This is a good goal, but it CANNOT be legislated! Your goal is an ATTITUDE in people's hearts, and you cannot legislate an attitude. Discrimination is not a symptom of a lack of laws, but a symptom of a lack of character in people's hearts. Your goal will be much better achieved by starting a process to grow this nation's CHARACTER, to teach the value of the individual, and to teach personal and moral dignity. This will not only build a people who know how to accept each other without agreeing to everything they believe/do, but it will benefit our productivity, our economy, our political influence and our overall stability as a nation.

We encourage you to take your eyes off creating more laws, and to focus instead on building CHARACTER – the quality and integrity of a person's heart that is becoming sorely missed in our society.
