

We request that you make no further restrictions with regard to antidiscrimination. We are particularly concerned about furthering the law to include sexuality & gender. It would seem to us all anti discrimination laws restrict freedoms of the majority whilst giving in to minorities.

In many countries & indeed even in Australia such laws have resulted in unfair prosecutions ; eg. The Wesley Mission & CYC camps Phillip Island.

To bring in a law that does not allow discrimination with regard to a persons sexuality or gender will (and has in some places) take away the freedom of choice , thought & religious conviction from many people, freedoms that are a basic human right.

Freedom is what our nation is proud of but to bring in such a law would take away the 'rights' of some groups & people.

It is not enough to perhaps allow religious groups & schools an exemption as this would probably be taken away at a later date.

All antidiscrimination laws restrict freedom, we are therefore opposed to any extension of antidiscrimination law.
