Dear Sir/Madam

I am writing to you to provide some ideas for submission to your panel making the decision regarding this Law reform.

I believe that sexuality and gender identity should not be included in the new changes to this law for the following reasons:

- 1/ Too many laws are creating a nightmare in the employment areas to select suitable job candidates (based on historical evidence that certain type of employees are more effective). This law change would force a business to be intimidated into poor choices (with legal challenges used as threats by unsuitable candidates using sexuality and gender clauses).
- 2/ People are still able to challenge discrimination decisions in court with the current laws. The new law will not give them any more protection.
- 3/ The addition of "sexuality and gender identity" law will discriminate against employers to make their own valid choices.
- 4/ It will prevent Religious organisations from selecting a suitable employee / volunteer for training / caring for their children and members.
- 5/ It will reduce the freedoms for choice, freedoms of religion and moral upbringing of our next generation by subverting our religious rules.

In summary I oppose the introduction of anti-discrimination law based on sexuality and gender identity.
